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### **MINUTES OF MEETING** **AUGUST 21, 2008**

#### **REGULAR MEETING OF THE OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD AUGUST 21, 2008**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Ohio Optical Dispensers Board (Board) began on Thursday, August 21, 2008, at 9:05 A.M. at 77 South High Street, West B & C, 31<sup>st</sup> Floor, Columbus. President Brian Miller called the meeting to order in open session.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS**

##### **Ordering of the Agenda**

The President and Executive Director reviewed the consent and regular agenda prior to the meeting.

IT WAS MOVED BY JOE BITONTE AND SECONDED BY MICHAEL HALL THAT THE CONSENT AGENDA FOR THE AUGUST 21, 2008 MEETING BE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. MOTION ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS.

IT WAS MOVED BY MICHAEL HALL AND SECONDED BY JAMES DEDARIO THAT THE REGULAR AGENDA FOR THE AUGUST 21, 2008 MEETING BE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. MOTION ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS.

### **President's Report**

President Miller welcomed the guests attending the meeting. Name tags had been provided to guests in order to facilitate communication between Board members and guests. President Miller encouraged Board members to introduce themselves to guests.

President Miller thanked the Board for the efficient job of completing the very full agenda at the June, 2008 Board meeting.

President Miller informed the Board that there have been no new developments in the process to change the law by the National Association of Opticians and Optometrists to allow spectacle licensed opticians to dispense contact lenses.

President Miller informed the Board that the Medicare accreditation for 2009 is still scheduled to go into affect and that the system has been tested to make sure everything will work as currently established.

### **Approval of Minutes**

IT WAS MOVED BY MICHAEL HALL AND SECONDED BY JAMES DEDARIO THAT THE MINUTES OF THE JUNE 19, 2008 BOARD MEETING BE APPROVED AS AMENDED. MOTION ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS.

### **Executive Director's Report**

Director Manns reminded the Board to turn in their time sheets to her on a weekly basis for time spent reviewing continuing education programs or any other approved Board functions between meetings in order that they will be paid for this time in a timely fashion.

Director Manns informed the Board that all Boards are preparing their budgets for fiscal years 2010 and 2011. Ms. Manns went on to remind the Board that the allotments for both 2010 and 2011 will be the same as the current FY '09 allotment.

Director Manns informed the Board that a copy of the LSC summary of the recent changes to the Board of Optometry laws was included in the packets handed out today. Ms. Manns brought to the attention the changes to this law that would require that an Optometrist place an expiration date on a prescription for contact lenses that mirrors the federal requirements. Other changes grant the ability to appropriately educated optometrists to write certain drug prescriptions.

Director Manns handed out a draft of the FY 2008 Annual Report and requested that the Board take it home to review and to bring it back with any proposed changes to the October Board meeting.

Director Manns informed the Board that the Board policies which had been approved at the June Board meeting had also been included in the Board packets.

Director Manns referred to the memo from the Governor regarding Board member attendance at Board meetings, and the memo regarding the purchase of food and meals. These memos reiterated current policies of the Strickland administration.

Director Manns informed the Board that she had included in the "FYI" section of the Board packet number 11.12 a copy of the Ohio Revised Code 3701.74 which describes and defines health care providers and pointed out that opticians are health care providers and must adhere to the health care record-keeping policies.

Director Manns informed the Board that her personal goals for 2008 and markers indicating progress toward meeting the goals were included in their Board packet. Ms. Manns indicated that the Board would receive at each Board meeting such updates that should be used by the Board members for evaluation of the Executive Director in the fall.

### **Approval of Financial Report**

After discussion,

IT WAS MOVED BY MICHAEL HALL AND SECONDED BY SUSAN C. BENES, M.D. THAT THE FINANCIAL REPORT FOR CURRENT FY 2009 BE ACCEPTED AS SUBMITTED. MOTION ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT.

### **Strategic Planning:**

#### **Systematic Plan for Review of Law Changes**

In accordance with the Board's goal for calendar year 2008 to conduct a review of Chapter 4725.40-4725.99 Ohio Revised Code (ORC), Director Manns had included in the Board members mailing packets a draft of revisions to Chapter 4725.45 – 4725.511 that had been discussed at the June, 2008 Board meeting. The Board reviewed these revisions extensively and by consensus agreed with the proposed language. The Board then reviewed and discussed at length proposed changes to Chapter 4725.51-4725.53 ORC. After review of those sections by Board members and comments from the Board members, and comments from visitors in the gallery, Director Manns informed the Board that she would once again draft language that would include the Board members' input into Chapter 4725.51-4725.53 ORC for review and discussion at the October, 2008 Board meeting. Also to be included would be various options and or policies to reinforce some of the changes discussed.

**A.A.G. Report:**

P.R. Casey, Assistant Attorney General, informed the Board that the Flagel Realty Company, Inc., Dayton, Ohio, continues to pursue through the Montgomery County Courts the requirement that the Board take receivership of the Northmont Opticians records and files. Mr. Casey informed the Board that the presiding judge ordered the realty company to provide a detailed inventory of the business' contents and to date that has not happened.

AAG Casey announced to the Board that he will be leaving the Attorney General's office since he has been offered and has accepted a position to work as an attorney for the Democrat Minority Caucus. AAG Casey thanked the Board members and staff for their support. Mr. Casey stated that his last day as AAG would be Friday, September 5, 2008. The Board members wished Mr. Casey the best in his future endeavors.

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### CONSENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN ELMER R. BUNGER AND THE OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between **ELMER R. BUNGER**, Optician License No. 9593-S and the **OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD** (“Board”), a state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4725 of the Ohio Revised Code, and all rules promulgated there under.

**ELMER R. BUNGER** enters into this CONSENT AGREEMENT being fully informed of his rights under Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, including the right to representation by counsel and the right to a formal adjudication hearing on the issues considered herein.

#### BASIS FOR ACTION

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. The **BOARD** is empowered by Section 4725.53 of the Ohio Revised Code to refuse to grant a license, suspend or revoke a license or impose a fine or order restitution for any of the enumerated violations.
2. The **BOARD** enters into this CONSENT AGREEMENT in lieu of formal proceedings based upon the violation of Section 4725.53(A)(1) (2) of the Ohio Revised Code. **ELMER R. BUNGER** was convicted of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude, three times in the past 10 years. In Grand Haven, MI on November 4, 1996 in the 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Case No. 96-019905-FH **ELMER R. BUNGER** was found guilty of Assault with Intent to Commit Sexual Penetration and Probation Violation, **MR. BUNGER** was placed on probation for 48 months. In Grand Haven, MI on November 29, 2001 in the 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, Case No. 01-25469-FH, **MR. BUNGER** was convicted of Assault with a Dangerous Weapon(Felonious Assault) and received 1 year, 6 months probation.

Also on January 25, 2008 in the Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile Division, Butler County, Ohio, Case No. JC2008-0071 **Mr. BUNGER** plead guilty to contributing to the unruliness of a minor, and one count of sexual imposition, and was determined to be a Tier II registered sex offender and as a result must register twice a year for 25 years. **Mr. BUNGER** also falsified his licensure application dated February 1, 2006, when he failed to disclose the conviction in Grand Haven, MI on November 4, 1996 in the 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit for Assault with Intent to Commit Sexual Penetration and Probation Violation.

3. The **BOARD** expressly reserves the right to institute additional formal proceedings based upon any other violations of Chapter 4725 of the Ohio Revised Code or any rules promulgated there under, whether occurring before or after the effective date of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**.

4. **ELMER R. BUNGER** is a Licensed Dispensing Optician in the State of Ohio, and holds license #9593-S, which expires January 1, 2009.

5. **ELMER R. BUNGER** admits the factual and legal allegations set forth in this Consent Agreement issued by the **BOARD**.

### **AGREED CONDITIONS**

**WHEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth and in lieu of any further formal proceedings at this time, **ELMER R. BUNGER** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms, conditions, and limitations:

- A. **ELMER R. BUNGER** will voluntarily and permanently surrender his license to practice opticianry in the State of Ohio #9593-S.
- B. **ELMER R. BUNGER** will not be eligible for re-instating his license under any condition.
- C. **ELMER R. BUNGER** will return his license #9593-S to the Board within 10 days of ratification of this agreement.

**FAILURE TO COMPLY**

By his signature on this agreement, **ELMER R. BUNGER** agrees that in the event the **BOARD**, in its discretion, does not approve this CONSENT AGREEMENT, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **ELMER R. BUNGER** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this CONSENT AGREEMENT and if this case proceeds to hearing, he will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this CONSENT AGREEMENT or of any information relating thereto.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS/LIABILITY RELEASE**

**ELMER R. BUNGER** waives any and all claims or causes of action he may have against the **BOARD**, and members, officers, employees and/or agents of the **BOARD**, arising out of the matters which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is not an adjudication order within the meaning of Section 119.01 (D) of the Ohio Revised Code.

Upon consent of **ELMER R. BUNGER** and the **BOARD**, the terms and conditions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT may be modified or terminated in writing.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

It is expressly understood that this CONSENT AGREEMENT is subject to ratification by the **BOARD** prior to signature by the President / Supervising Disciplinary Member and shall become effective upon the last date of signature below.
