MINUTES OF MEETING

April 10, 2014

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD APRIL 10, 2014

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Ohio Optical Dispensers Board (Board) began on Thursday, April 10, 2014 at 9:15 A.M. at 77 South High Street, 31ST Floor, Columbus, Ohio. President Jeffrey R. Rohlf called the meeting to order in open session.

Ordering of the Agenda

The President and Executive Director reviewed the consent agenda prior to the meeting.

The President and Executive Director reviewed the regular agenda prior to the meeting.

President's Report

President Rohlf welcomed The Board's new Assistant Attorney General, J. T. Wakley as well as the guests in the gallery. President Rohlf expressed that he had been honored to have served as President of the Board the past year and found that his time as a President had been very educational.

Approval of Minutes

Executive Director’s Report

Director Manns reported the following statistics regarding the 2014 licensure renewal:

- 3,267 renewal forms were mailed;
- 3,167 renewed =97% of those eligible to renew did so.

Of those who renewed, 81 renewed late and paid the late fee of \$75.00 for a total of \$6,075.00 in late fees.

Director Manns informed the Board that Ms. Simmons, The Board’s Administrative Professional 4, had completed Part II of Phase 1 of the User Acceptance Testing for the new eLicensing system. Additional problems were identified during the testing. In addition it was announced that out of the original 13 Boards who have been assigned to the “First Wave,” only four Boards will go forward into the next phase with the potential of going live in mid-August, 2014. The Optical Dispensers Board is not one of the four to be included in this group.

Director Manns informed the Board that all rules of the Board are required to be reviewed every five years for the “Five Year Rule Review.” The last five-year review of Chapter 4726 of the Ohio Administrative Code was completed in 2010, which means the Board will begin to review/revise as needed all rules during 2014 and part of 2015. This process will begin at the June 19, 2014 Board meeting. The Board has a total of 32 rules divided over nine Chapters of rules that will need to be reviewed for revisions, rescission or re-affirmation.

Issuance of Licenses: Director Manns reported the following statistics:

Director Manns informed the Board that House Bill 258 dealing with Scope of practice for spectacle opticians passed out of the House, and on November 19, 2013 was referred to the Senate Medicaid, Health and Human Services Committee. Ms. Manns went on to say that no further action had occurred related to HB 258 at the time of the Board meeting.

Director Manns informed the Board that House Bill 466 dealing with the transfer of the Optical Dispensers Board was referred on March 11, 2014 to the House, Health and Aging Committee and that no further action had been taken at the time of the Board meeting.

Director Manns informed the Board that House Bill 98 dealing with Military Revisions to Licensure Laws passed and was signed by the Governor on November 15, 2013. This Bill requires promulgation of rules for licensure by Boards and Commissions. The purpose of the legislation and consequently, rules, was to accelerate licensure for members of the Armed Forces, veterans, and, in certain circumstances, spouses of members and veterans.

Director Manns informed the Board that the Ohio Ethics Commission extended the financial disclosure filing deadline from April 15, 2014 to May 15, 2014 to allow those filers who may be using the electronic filing system for the first time adequate time to prepare needed documents.

Director Manns further requested that Board Members file as soon as possible and to let her know when the Board member had completed the process.

American Board of Opticianry (ABO) and National Contact Lens Examiners (NCLE) Exam Processes – James Morris, Esq., Executive Director ABO-NCLE

Director Morris reported to the Board that ABO/NCLE had begun an outreach program including meeting with individual state licensing boards to answer any questions the licensing boards may have about the current licensure exams, changes to the processes of ABO/NCLE, and future plans. Director Morris explained that the certification exam was converted to a computer-based exam including on-line registration for the exam. Mr. Morris went on to say that ABO/NCLE had made several changes to their webpage, including an on-line database to verify current certifications. Director Morris added that another change was made to allow individuals to renew their ABO and/or NCLE certification based on current licensure in a state requiring continuing education to renew their respective license. Director Morris explained that processes would continue to be employed to evaluate and update the exam in addition to altering questions to meet current practice standards. The OAA, NAO and CLSA are to develop study guides for the exam. Future plans are to go from giving the exam two times a year to four times, then six times and eventually 12 times a year. There will be a 6 month ban when an individual fails the test prior to being able to take it again.

Information regarding National Federation of Opticianry Schools (NFOS) and the Commission on Accreditation of Ophthalmic Medical Programs (COA) was provided to Board members. Ms. Manns explained that the two organizations, although they have similar goals, each organization has a different purpose:

The National Federation of Opticianry Schools (NFOS) is dedicated to the promotion of formal opticianry education offered by accredited educational institutions; and, is an association of opticianry schools dedicated to facilitating the development of formal educational programs. The Commission on Accreditation of Ophthalmic Medical Programs (COA) is a credentialing organization that establishes criteria for opticianry educational programs and accredits programs that meet stringent criteria.

A listing of members of each organization was provided.
