MINUTES OF MEETING

April 2, 2015

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD APRIL 2, 2015

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Ohio Optical Dispensers Board (Board) began on Thursday, April 2, 2015 at 9:09 A.M. at 77 South High Street, 31st Floor, Columbus, Ohio. President Thomas Barracato called the meeting to order in open session.

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Ordering of the Agenda

The President and Executive Director reviewed the consent agenda prior to the meeting.

IT WAS MOVED BY BRIAN J MILLER AND SECONDED BY SUSAN ROBUS THAT THE CONSENT AGENDA FOR THE APRIL 2, 2015 MEETING BE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. MOTION ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT.

The President and Executive Director reviewed the regular agenda prior to the meeting.

President's Report

President Barracato welcomed the guests in the gallery, welcomed new Board Member Rebecca Kuhns and thanked V.P. Robus for acting as chair in his absence at the January, 2015 Board meeting.

Approval of Minutes

IT WAS MOVED BY SUSAN ROBUS AND SECONDED BY PAUL R. KING THAT THE MINUTES OF THE JANUARY 22, 2015 BOARD MEETING BE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. MOTION ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT.

Executive Director’s Report

Director Manns informed the Board that the statistics as of March 18th for license renewals is as follows; 3272 renewals mailed, 3105 renewed which equals 95% of those eligible to renew as compared to 97% the previous year. Of those renewing 80 renewed late which amounted to \$6000 in late fees paid. The renewal period ended at midnight on March 31, 2015.

Director Manns informed the Board that it has been officially announced that the contract with Iron Data, the original company that was to implement the new e-Licensing system, has been terminated. The cause for this termination was cited as missed deadlines by Iron Data. A search has been started and Request for Proposals has been solicited for a new system. The expectation is that a new provider will be chosen by the end of June, 2015.

Director Manns informed the Board that she presented Budget Testimony before the House of Higher Education Financial Sub-Committee on Wednesday, February 25, 2015. The only questions from the Representatives dealt with the 4K9 fund which has minimal impact on the Board’s budget.

Director Manns informed the Board that the initial interview with state auditors for the FY’14-’15 budget years was held on Tuesday, March 17, 2015 in the Board office. The audit will be conducted over the next three months. This audit is performed by the Auditor of State biannually.

Issuance of Licenses: Director Manns reported the following statistics:

Director Manns informed the Board that the revisions to the contract between the Board and ABO/NCLE remain on-going.

Director Manns informed the Board that a formal opinion request has been sent to the Opinions Section of Ohio Attorney General DeWine’s Office on February 10, 2015. An opinion was asked regarding two issues:

1. Does the new legislation eliminate the exemption for continuing education for the first renewal after initial licensure? For both spectacle and contact lens licensees?
2. Does the new legislation permit a spectacle only licensee to order contact lenses/dispense only in-stock contact lenses?

A response was received from the AG’s office that the formal request had been received and the request would be considered public information since the Board did not wish for the file to be confidential; and the AG’s office would “commence preparation of a formal opinion in response to your request”.

Director Manns informed the Board that she had participated in a Media Relations Training Program on February 26, 2015 that was conducted by Beth Gianforcaro, Deputy Director, Communications, Ohio Department of Administrative Services. The training provided tips for handling media requests, how to respond to requests for information; how the Ratings, Nielsen & Sweeps affect the number and types of request; especially interviews; prepare for media responses and provided effective media relations tips.

Optical Dispensers Board
April 2, 2015

Director Manns further informed the Board that after 17 years as Executive Director of the OOA, Rick Cornett has retired. Keith Kerns is the new Executive Director.

Director Manns informed the Board that Optician Barbi Tuckerman, of Grandview was featured in the Sunday, March 15, 2015 edition of the Columbus Dispatch. The article focused on her passion for glasses, and, how to find the perfect pair of frames for each client. Ms. Tuckerman eloquently presented her perspective on the importance of customer relations.

Director Manns informed the Board that Rebecca M. Kuhns had been appointed to the Board as a Consumer Member, replacing James Fortune. Rebecca (Becca) is a graduate of the Ohio State University and has extensive experience working with state legislators as a legislative aide. She is currently employed by McDonald Hopkins as the Manager for State and Local Government Affairs. Ms. Manns went on to say that she met with Ms. Kuhns on Monday, March 23, 2015 to conduct a board member orientation.

American Academy of Ophthalmology/Development of Standards for Online Eyewear Prescriptions:

Dr. Jeffrey Hutchison presented information to the Board concerning the American Academy of Ophthalmology's initiative to develop standards that will serve as guidance for a certification program for on-line eyewear retailers to ensure that ophthalmology standards are not compromised with respect to the handling of prescriptions, as well as patient/physician information.

Legit Script, an international certification organization, was awarded a contract to develop the program that will provide certification for eyeglass prescriptions verification, transparency regarding the identity of the owner/operator of internet websites; and, the customer/patient privacy protection initiative. *Legit Script* plans to model the program after the successfully implemented Verified Internet Pharmacy Practice Sites program conducted by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy.

Paper: Opticianry Licensing in the US:

A paper published in the U.S. News and World Report, "Bringing the Effects of Occupational Licensing into Focus: Optician Licensing in the United States" written by Edward J. Timmons and Anna Mills, Mercatus Center, George Mason University was discussed by the Board. The

consensus of the Board members was that the response from the Opticians Association of America to the U.S. News and World Report accurately reflected the opinion of the Board as a whole; that the data collected was outdated, incorrect, and did not accurately portray the true state of opticianry and that the data used in the study did not support their own conclusions.

Election of Officers:
