June 4, 2015

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD JUNE 4, 2015

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Ohio Optical Dispensers Board (Board) began on Thursday, June 4, 2015 at 9:05A.M. at 77 South High Street, 31st Floor, Columbus, Ohio. President Jeffrey R. Rohlf called the meeting to order in open session.

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Ordering of the Agenda

The President and Executive Director reviewed the consent agenda prior to the meeting.

IT WAS MOVED BY BRIAN J MILLER AND SECONDED BY SUSAN ROBUS THAT THE CONSENT AGENDA FOR THE JUNE 4, 2015 MEETING BE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. MOTION ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT.

The President and Executive Director reviewed the regular agenda prior to the meeting.

IT WAS MOVED BY TIMOTHY FRIES, O.D. AND SECONDED BY BRIAN J MILLER THAT THE REGULAR AGENDA FOR THE JUNE 4, 2015 MEETING BE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. MOTION ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT.

President's Report

President Rohlf welcomed the guests in the gallery, and thanked the Board for their support in his role as president of the Board. President Rohlf stated that in keeping with the precedent of past presidents, he would not be voting on any motions during his year as president unless a tie occurred and his vote was necessary to break a tie vote. President Rohlf informed the guests present in the gallery that if individuals wished to address the Board, they should wait to be recognized by the President before addressing the Board members.

Approval of Minutes

IT WAS MOVED BY SUSAN ROBUS AND SECONDED BY REBECCA M. KUHNS THAT THE MINUTES OF THE APRIL 2, 2015 BOARD MEETING BE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. MOTION ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT.

Executive Director’s Report

Director Manns informed the Board that 1,541 Apprentice renewals were mailed on May 6, 2015. As of June 1, 2015 about 300 individuals have renewed.

Director Manns informed the Board that classes and development of the new e-licensing system have started with Deloitte Consulting. The Sanitarium Registration, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Athletic Trainers Board and the Medical Board have been involved in the initial development of the system. Preliminary reports from individuals involved in this early process have been very positive. The expectation is that all licensing boards will “go live” within the next year.

Director Manns informed the Board that she presented Budget Testimony before the Senate Finance Corrections Sub-Committee on Thursday, May 7, 2015.

Director Manns informed the Board that the biennial audit data gathering by the State Auditor’s office had been concluded until after the end of the Fiscal year 2015, June 30, 2015. Final findings are expected to be shared with the staff of the Board sometime in July, 2015.

Issuance of Licenses: Director Manns reported the following statistics:

Director Manns informed the Board that the revisions to the contract between the Board and ABO/NCLE remain on-going.

Director Manns informed the Board that a formal opinion request has been sent to the Opinions Section of Ohio Attorney General DeWine’s Office on February 10, 2015. An opinion was asked regarding two issues:

1. Does HB 258 eliminate the exemption for continuing education for the first renewal after initial licensure? For both spectacle and contact lens licensees?
2. Does HB 258 permit a spectacle only licensee to order contact lenses/dispense only in-stock contact lenses?

A copy of the formal opinion was previously forwarded to Board members under separate cover.

Director Manns informed the Board that the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) has been working with Boards who regulate health care professionals to develop a series of questions to be asked on each licensure renewal. The questions are extensive and are meant to capture where there may be a shortage of health care professionals in Ohio’s future. The aim is to provide data for workforce forecasting, policy development and research. The data could also be used to identify both barriers and solutions to improve recruitment and retention of health care providers serving Ohio’s population. The Ohio State University is working concurrently with the Ohio Department of Health on this project. Director Manns stated that she had attended a meeting on April 28, 2015 with several other directors who provided feedback to representatives of The Ohio State University about the types of questions, the formatting of the questions and eliminating duplication of questions. Questions are centered around levels of education/highest degree earned and employment/types of practice, hours worked and if an individual is currently working in the profession for which they are licensed.

Director Manns also informed the Board that it was learned late Friday, May 29, 2015 that the Columbus Convention Center was hosting the annual Halloween Costume/Accessories the weekend of May 29 – May 31, 2015. Director Manns placed several phone calls to Ms. Amy Schmitz, the event coordinator, to remind the planners that it was illegal to sell/dispense contact lenses without a prescription and dispensed by a licensed dispenser; that the Board, in conjunction with the Attorney General’s office, had successfully prevented dealers from dispensing at the convention center the previous year. A copy of the formal letter from the AG’s office was forwarded to Ms. Schmitz.

AAG Report

AAG J. T. Wakley informed the Board that there are no pending hearings or pending actions related to the Board. AAG Wakley further informed that Board that he wanted to discuss the Attorney General's opinion regarding the two questions submitted. As respects to whether the Board could change the requirements of waiving first year continuing education requirements the opinion was there currently is no exemption in the law to grant first time renewals from the continuing education requirements. The second question was in regards to whether the recent change with HB 258 would also allow the licensee to order through the computer system; the AG's opinion was that the language in HB 258 permitted the ordering of pre-packaged contact lenses by spectacle licensed opticians.

Information Related To HB 125 Veterans Fee Waiver Program:

HB 125 was introduced to expand privileges to veterans by establishing the Veterans Fee Waiver Program which would provide some exemption from paying certain fees; and, would require the Board to list those exemptions on the Board's web page.

ABO/NCLE Memorandum/Practicum Exam:

Board member King requested that Director Manns also contact NCSORB and ABO-NCLE to request a demo and presentation of their respective computerized practicums to the Board at the August, 2015 Board meeting; and, suggested that both ABO/NCLE and NCSORB submit an outline of their presentation to be given to each Board member prior to the August Board meeting. Board member King also requested that a draft of rules for the practicum and the limitation to on-line continuing education be given to each Board member prior to the August Board meeting.

Information Regarding HB 213; Change to Biennial Renewal:

HB 213, as introduced, would require the Board to initiate biennial renewals for licensees. Fees would be increased; continuing education requirements would be increased to meet the two year renewal process.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between **JONATHON RUNCAN**, Opticians, License No. 9719-S and the **OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD** ("Board"), a state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4725 of the Ohio Revised Code, and all rules promulgated thereunder.

JONATHON RUNCAN enters into this CONSENT AGREEMENT being fully informed of his rights under Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, including the right to representation by counsel and the right to a formal adjudication hearing on the issues considered herein.

BASIS FOR ACTION

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. The **BOARD** is empowered by Section 4725.53 of the Ohio Revised Code to refuse to grant a license, suspend or revoke a license or impose a fine or order restitution for any of the enumerated violations.
2. The **BOARD** enters into this CONSENT AGREEMENT in lieu of formal proceedings based upon the violation of Section 4725.51 of the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code 4726-7-02(G)(1) **JONATHON RUNCAN** failed to obtain his continuing education credits within the immediately preceding one-year period, namely January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014, for renewal of his optical license for the 2015 renewal period. Continuing education certificates received as part of the renewal for the 2015 licensure period and reviewed by the Board showed that these credits were obtained on March 16, 2015.

3. The **BOARD** expressly reserves the right to institute additional formal proceedings based upon any other violations of Chapter 4725 of the Ohio Revised Code or any rules promulgated there under, whether occurring before or after the effective date of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**.
4. **JONATHON RUNCAN** is a Licensed Dispensing Optician in the State of Ohio, and holds license number 9719-S.
5. **JONATHON RUNCAN** admits the factual and legal allegations set forth in this Consent Agreement issued by the **BOARD**.

AGREED CONDITIONS

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth and in lieu of any further formal proceedings at this time, **JONATHON RUNCAN** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms, conditions, and limitations:

- A. **JONATHON RUNCAN** shall obtain four (4) additional Spectacle continuing education hours, that will be applied toward her 2016 license renewal. The four (4) additional Spectacle hours cannot be the same as those obtained for his 2015 renewal. The four (4) additional Spectacle hours must be received by the Board at the Ohio Optical Dispensers Board, 77 South High Street, 16th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215-6108 not later than 30 days from the ratification by the Board of this consent agreement..
- B. **JONATHON RUNCAN** agrees and acknowledges that this disciplinary action shall be entered in the **BOARD'S** journal and will be maintained in his licensure file.
- C **JONATHON RUNCAN** shall obey all laws and rules of the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code governing Licensed Opticians in Ohio.

D. The **BOARD** agrees not to institute formal proceedings against **JONATHOIN RUNCAN** as long as he is in compliance with the terms and conditions of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**.

FAILURE TO COMPLY

If, in the discretion of the Board or its Designate, **MR. RUNCAN** appears to have violated or breached any term or condition of this Agreement, the Board reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings pursuant to ORC 4725.53 or rules promulgated under OAC 4726 for any and all possible violations or breaches, including but limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**.

Any action initiated by the Board based on alleged violations of this Agreement shall comply with the Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 119, of the Ohio Revised Code.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS/LIABILITY RELEASE

JONATHON RUNCAN agrees that in the event the Board, in its discretion, does not ratify this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **MR. RUNCAN** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** and if this case proceeds to hearing, he will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by this review and discussion of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** or of any information relating thereto.

MR. RUNCAN acknowledges that he has had an opportunity to ask questions concerning the terms of this Consent Agreement and that all questions asked have been answered in a satisfactory manner.

MR. RUNCAN waives all of his rights under Chapter 119, ORC, as they relate to matters that are the subject of this Consent Agreement.

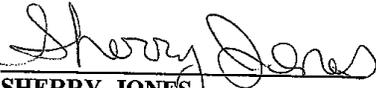
