President's Report

President Miller welcomed the guests in the gallery, and thanked the Board for their vote of confidence in the election of Board officers at the April, 2016 Board meeting. President Miller advised the Board that during his tenure as president he would only vote on motions only when necessary to complete a quorum or in the case of a tie. President Miller further advised the Board members to speak up so that everyone in the meeting could

hear all comments being made, and, that anything spoken in the Open Public Meeting would be subject to be recorded in the minutes. Mr. Miller congratulated Dr. Fries on the arrival of baby boy Fries on May 11th.

Approval of Minutes

IT WAS MOVED BY SUSAN ROBUS AND SECONDED BY REBECCA M. KUHNS THAT THE MINUTES OF THE APRIL 7, 2016 BOARD MEETING BE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. MOTION ADOPTED.

Executive Director’s Report

Director Manns informed the Board that approximately 1600 Apprentice renewal notices were mailed out May 9, 2016. As of June 15, 2016, 799 renewals have been completed. Director Manns advised the Board to keep in mind that the number mailed and renewed does not reflect the total number of actual apprentices since some individuals have more than one apprenticeship.

Director Manns also informed the Board that the testing results from the ABO/NCLE May, 2016 exams had not been received as of this date.

Issuance of Licenses: Director Manns reported the following statistics:

Director Manns informed the Board that there has been a slight increase in the amount of time from the “Received Date” to the “Received to Approved Date”. She went on to say that this increase has been due generally to an increased amount of time to get the score reports from ABO/NCLE, and, receipt of the BCI/FBI reports, both of which the Board has no control over. However, Director Manns noted that the “Complete to Approved” time has decreased.

Director Manns informed the Board that on May 24, 2016 the Sunset Review Committee voted to make the recommendation to the State legislature to combine the Optical Dispensers Board with the State Board of Optometry, Director Manns went on to say that it is important to remember that this was a recommendation only and that any changes to the structure of the Board must go through the legislative process. This process includes taking testimony, written and in person, from interested parties. The legislators will be on summer break, but have posted sessions that are scheduled for November and December. The scheduled dates were included in Director Manns’ report.

Director Manns informed the Board that HB213 introduced by Representative Brinkman, if passed, would require Boards who renew licenses annually to change to biennial renewal and would then permit a licensee to take continuing education courses on-line. There has been no activity on the bill since April 19, 2016.

Director Manns informed the Board that HB216 introduced by Senator Burke, if passed, would exempt the first \$500 of prescription eye glasses, contact lenses and other optical aids sold by licensed dispensers from sales and use tax. On February 10, 2016 the Ohio State Medical Association testified in opposition to the Bill as it relates to Advanced Practice Nurses. The House version of the Bill passed out of the House by a vote of 96-1 on May 25, 2016.

Director Manns informed the Board that the annual Ethics Training had been completed by the staff of the Board and that information regarding the on-line Ethics course was emailed to Board members on May 23, 2016.

Director Manns informed the Board that, as requested, information had been gathered regarding Survey Monkey and a copy of the different levels/costs for Survey Monkey and that services provided in each level and cost were in the Board's packet.
