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MINUTES OF MEETING

March 16, 2017

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD MARCH 16, 2017

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Ohio Optical Dispensers Board (Board) began on Thursday, March 16, 2017 at 9:03 A.M. at 77 South High Street, 31ST Floor, Columbus, Ohio. President Brian J Miller called the meeting to order in open session.

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Ordering of the Agenda:

The President and Executive Director reviewed the consent agenda prior to the meeting.

IT WAS MOVED BY SUSAN ROBUS AND SECONDED BY SUE POHLER THAT THE CONSENT AGENDA FOR THE MARCH 16, 2017 MEETING BE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. MOTION ADOPTED.

The President and Executive Director reviewed the regular agenda prior to the meeting.

President's Report:

President Miller welcomed the guests and requested that they introduce themselves. President Miller also informed the Board that this would be AAG Alex Armitage's last meeting with the Board as he has taken a position with another Board.

Approval of Minutes:

Executive Director’s Report:

Director Manns informed the Board that the staff, particularly Wilma and Eric, had been spending multiple days and hours working with the representatives of Sales Force to construct the new e-licensing system which is expected to go live on June 20, 2017. Director Manns went on to say that the current e-licensing system will be down completely with no access to licensees from June 1, 2017 through June 19, 2017. For that reason, the renewal information for all registered apprentices was mailed the first week of March. E-blasts have been strongly encouraging apprentices to complete the renewal process by the end of May, 2017. Director Manns added that any paper documents/applications that come into the Board office during that time period will have to be entered into the new system by staff after June 19, 2017, which will most likely result in delays for issuance of the renewed certificates. Any paper documents coming into the Board office after June 20th will be returned to the sender and they will be advised to go to the new licensing system to enter their information and to set up a “profile.” The new prefix, starting immediately for apprentice opticians will be AOP; an Ocularist apprentice will be AOC. The prefix for Licensed Opticians will be OP. Apprentice opticians will be “AOP” Apprentice opticians

Director Manns informed the Board that she provided budget testimony to the House Government and Agency Review Sub-Committee, Chaired by Representative Faber on February 16, 2017. The testimony lasted approximated 50 minutes with extensive questions by the sub-committee. The questions centered more on processes than the actual requested monies. There were also some questions about the effect of the consolidation.

Issuance of Licenses: Director Manns reported the following statistics:

Director Manns informed the Board that the numbers are an improvement over the last month and reflect the norm from previous reports.

Other Business:

President Miller opened the floor for Director Mark Glasper to address the requirements of taking the Spectacle Contact Lens Dispensing (SCD) class for new licensees and for the renewals thereafter of Spectacle Licensed Opticians. Director Manns referred everyone to 4725.51 (a) (b) and read what was stated in the statutes. After discussion by all it was suggested that Director Manns and incoming Director Eagan look into this to see if there is a need for a law change and to bring it back to the next Board meeting. Board member Pohler suggested reaching out to other out of state Opticianry licensing Boards to see what regulations exist in other states regarding this issue.

Dr. Fries informed the Board regarding the new bill regarding sales tax which he stated was similar to the one introduced last year; however, this bill will eliminate any sales tax on optical goods.

Hearing no other issues for discussion, President Miller requested a motion to adjourn the Board Meeting.

**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
KATHLEEN SINKINSON
AND
THE OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD**

CASE#2017-ODB-01005

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between **KATHLEEN SINKINSON**, Opticians, License No. 4782-S and the **OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD** (“Board”), a state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4725 of the Ohio Revised Code, and all rules promulgated thereunder.

KATHLEEN SINKINSON enters into this CONSENT AGREEMENT being fully informed of her rights under Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, including the right to representation by counsel and the right to a formal adjudication hearing on the issues considered herein.

BASIS FOR ACTION

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. The **BOARD** is empowered by Section 4725.53 of the Ohio Revised Code to refuse to grant a license, suspend or revoke a license or impose a fine or order restitution for any of the enumerated violations.
2.
