MINUTES OF MEETING **September 4, 2014**

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD SEPTEMBER 4, 2014

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Ohio Optical Dispensers Board (Board) began on Thursday, September 4, 2014 at 9:00 A.M. at 77 South High Street, 31st Floor, Columbus, Ohio. Vice President Susan Robus called the meeting to order in open session.

Ordering of the Agenda

The Vice President and Executive Director reviewed the consent agenda prior to the meeting.

Vice President's Report

Vice President Robus welcomed the guests in the gallery and informed the Board that she would be presiding over the meeting since President Barracato was attending a national conference in Nashville, TN.

Executive Director's Report

Director Manns informed the Board that Apprentice registration renewals were mailed the first part of May and ended midnight June 30, 2014. Of the 1,470 renewals mailed, 1,193 (81%) have renewed. However, since the first of June, the Board has issued 50 licenses and has registered an additional 180 apprenticeship registrations since that time.

Director Manns reported that there have been no updates on our Board's scheduled implementation for the E-Licensing 2.0 system. The first four Boards of the original 19 Boards are expected to be on-line in November, 2014. It does appear that our Board will be among the last group in Wave One to go live which means it could be another year before we switch over to the new system.

Director Manns informed the Board that although we have just started FY'15, Board Directors are already working on the FY'16-FY'17 Budget. Budget for the next biennium is due by September 17, 2014. Although the due date for the next budget is mid-September, Board Directors have not been given approximate costs for FY'16-FY'17 items, such as rent, IT costs, e-licensure costs among others.

Issuance of Licenses: Director Manns reported the following statistics:

These numbers are staying fairly stable. However, we are seeing a slight increase in the average time from receipt of the application to approval because of delays in the receipt of the FBI/BCII results.

Director Manns informed the Board that we have been using Skip Jack through Fifth Third for our on-line renewal transactions. A new contract has been awarded to Elavon/Key Bank. Transitions to the new system began August 1, 2014. Ms. Simmons and Director Manns attended training on the new credit card processing system on Friday, August 22, 2014.

Director Manns informed the Board that a copy of Rule 4726-5-06 (OAC) related to military revisions for initial licensure and licensure renewal as final filed was placed in each Board member's packet. The new rules became effective August 5, 2014. Five-year rule review date for this particular rule will be 01/15/2017 in keeping with the rest of the rules found in Chapter 5. A new section on "Military Benefits" has been added to the Board's web page to provide a quick resource for veterans and military members regarding the recent changes. This section is specific to the new rules and provides a summary of the licensure and renewal of licenses for military members and veterans as well as their spouses. All new applications now ask the question if the applicant is a military veteran or a member.

Director Manns informed the Board that the pass rates for the May, 2014 exam for Ohio test takers were as follows:



This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between LAURIE McKNIGHT, Opticians, License No. 7095-S and the OHIO OPTICAL DISPENSERS BOARD ("Board"), a state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4725 of the Ohio Revised Code, and all rules promulgated thereunder.

LAURIE McKNIGHT enters into this CONSENT AGREEMENT being fully informed of her rights under Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, including the right to representation by counsel and the right to a formal adjudication hearing on the issues considered herein.

BASIS FOR ACTION

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. The BOARD is empowered by Section 4725.53 of the Ohio Revised Code to refuse to grant a license, suspend or revoke a license or impose a fine or order restitution for any of the enumerated violations.
2. The BOARD enters into this CONSENT AGREEMENT in lieu of formal proceedings based upon the violation of Section 4725.51 of the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code 4726-7-02(G)(1) LAURIE McKNIGHT failed to obtain her continuing education credits within the immediately preceding one-year period, namely January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013, for renewal of her optical license for the 2014 renewal period. Continuing education certificates received as part of the renewal for the 2014 licensure period and reviewed by the Board showed that these credits were obtained on March 29, 2014

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3. The **BOARD** expressly reserves the right to institute additional formal proceedings based upon any other violations of Chapter 4725 of the Ohio Revised Code or any rules promulgated there under, whether occurring before or after the effective date of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**.

4. **LAURIE McKNIGHT** is a Licensed Dispensing Optician in the State of Ohio, and holds license number 7095-S

5. **LAURIE McKNIGHT** admits the factual and legal allegations set forth in this Consent Agreement issued by the **BOARD**.

AGREED CONDITIONS

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth and in lieu of any further formal proceedings at this time, **LAURIE McKNIGHT** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms, conditions, and limitations:

A. **LAURIE McKNIGHT** shall obtain four (4) additional Spectacle continuing education hours, that will be applied toward her 2015 license renewal. The four (4) additional Spectacle hours cannot be the same as those obtained for her 2013 renewal. The four (4) additional Spectacle hours must be received by the Board at the Ohio Optical Dispensers Board, 77 South High Street, 16th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215-6108 not later than 30 days from the ratification by the Board of this consent agreement..

B. **LAURIE McKNIGHT** agrees and acknowledges that this disciplinary action shall be entered in the **BOARD'S** journal and will be maintained in her licensure file.

C. **LAURIE McKNIGHT** shall obey all laws and rules of the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code governing Licensed Opticians in Ohio.

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D. The **BOARD** agrees not to institute formal proceedings against **LAURIE McKNIGHT** as long as she is in compliance with the terms and conditions of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**.

FAILURE TO COMPLY

If, in the discretion of the Board or its Designate, **MS. McKNIGHT** appears to have violated or breached any term or condition of this Agreement, the Board reserves the right to institute formal disciplinary proceedings pursuant to ORC 4725.53 or rules promulgated under OAC 4726 for any and all possible violations or breaches, including but limited to, alleged violations of the laws of Ohio occurring before the effective date of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**.

Any action initiated by the Board based on alleged violations of this Agreement shall comply with the Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 119, of the Ohio Revised Code.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS/LIABILITY RELEASE

LAURIE McKNIGHT agrees that in the event the Board, in its discretion, does not ratify this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **MS. McKNIGHT** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** and if this case proceeds to hearing, she will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by this review and discussion of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** or of any information relating thereto.

MS. McKNIGHT acknowledges that she has had an opportunity to ask questions concerning the terms of this Consent Agreement and that all questions asked have been answered in a satisfactory manner.

MS. McKNIGHT waives all of her rights under Chapter 119, ORC, as they relate to matters that are the subject of this Consent Agreement.
